1. The following individual will be the *only* persons permitted to serve alcoholic beverages:

Joseph Cerami, Albert Pepe, Kevin Phillips and Craig Tuma. Address on file in Police Headquarters.

- 2. No one under the age of 21 shall be served alcoholic beverages. The Stirling Volunteer Fire Company #1 or it's designee shall be responsible for verifying the ages of those patrons who wish to consume alcoholic beverages, by issuing colored wrist bands to identify those patrons.
- 3. No person assumed to be under the influence of an alcoholic beverage shall be served or allowed to walk or drive from the Stirling Volunteer Fire Co. #1 Headquarters.
- 4. The consumption of alcoholic beverages shall be restricted to the interior of the Stirling Fire Co. #1 Headquarters. No alcoholic beverages are to be carried or consumed in the parking lot area.
- 5. Alcoholic beverages shall only be served and/or consumed between the hours of 6:00 p.m. and 11:59 p.m. on February 1, 2014.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Long Hill, in the County of Morris, State of New Jersey as follows:

- 1. The Township Committee, the licensing authority of the municipality, has no objection to the granting of a special permit and consents thereto with the special conditions as outlined by the Chief of Police.
- 2. The Township Clerk is hereby authorized to sign the municipal certification on the application and forward it to the applicant.
