- 2. No person under the age of 21 shall be served alcoholic beverages. The Stirling Volunteer Fire Company No. 1 or it's designee shall be responsible for verifying the ages of those patrons who wish to consume alcoholic beverages and monitor the area to prevent "hand off's."
- 3. No person assumed to be under the influence of an alcoholic beverage shall be served or allowed to walk or drive from the Stirling Volunteer Fire Co. #1 or the designated area.
- 4. The consumption of alcoholic beverages shall be restricted to the fenced in/grove area located directly behind the Stirling Volunteer Fire Company No. 1's property, as outlined in the map supplied with the application. No alcoholic beverages shall be possessed or consumed in any area not designated on this map.

However, in the event of inclement weather, the event could be moved to the interior of the Stirling Fire Company, at which point the consumption of alcoholic beverages shall be restricted to the interior of the Stirling Fire Company building.

5. Alcoholic beverages shall only be served and/or consumed between the hours of 11:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m. on May 26, 2014.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Township Committee of the Township of Long Hill, in the County of Morris, State of New Jersey as follows:

- 1. The Township Committee, the licensing authority of the municipality, has no objection to the granting of a special permit and consents thereto with the special conditions as outlined by the Chief of Police.
