MUNCIPAL RESOURCES, INC. FOR FIRE DEPARTMENT STUDY/REVIEW

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WHEREAS, the Township may award contracts for "Extraordinary, Unspecifiable Services ("EUS") without competitive bids in accordance with the requirements of *N.J.S.A. 40A:11-5(1)(a)(ii)* and *N.J.A.C. 5:34.2*; and

WHEREAS, there exists a need for a consultant to conduct a fire department study/review as described in the EUS certification attached hereto; and

WHEREAS, this contract is being awarded pursuant to a "fair and open process" as that term is defined in N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.7, and, therefore, is not subject to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.4; and

WHEREAS, the Township Chief Financial Officer in accordance with the requirements of N.J.A.C. 5:34-5 has certified in writing to the Township Council the availability of adequate funds to pay the maximum amount of the contract; and

WHEREAS, this resolution and the EUS contract shall be kept on file and available for public inspection in the office of the Township Clerk; and

WHEREAS, the Township Administrator prepared a request for proposals dated October 12, 2017 for professional consulting services to conduct a study/review of the Long Hill Township Fire Department; and

WHEREAS, the Township received proposals from four interested consultants on November 10, 2017; and

WHEREAS, the proposal submitted by Municipal Resources, Inc. best meets the needs of the Township and the proposed project; and

WHEREAS, the total proposal submitted by Municipal Resources, Inc. is for \$24,275.00, of which \$6,068.75 is to be paid upon execution of the contract and which will cover preliminary work under the contract; and

WHEREAS, the Township Administrator recommends the award of the contract to Municipal Resources, Inc. in accordance with its proposal:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Committee of the Township of Long Hill, in the County of Morris, State of New Jersey as follows:

- An EUS contract to conduct a fire department study/review is hereby awarded to Municipal Resources, Inc. in accordance with the scope of work set forth in the RFP and its proposal dated November 10, 2017. The total contract cost shall not exceed \$6,068.75 during calendar year 2017.
- This contract award is contingent upon and subject to the Township Attorney's approval as to the form of the contract.
- If the Township Attorney approves the form of a contract with Municipal Resources, Inc., the Mayor and Clerk are authorized to execute that agreement.
- 4. The Contractor's Business Disclosure Entity Certification shall be placed on file with this resolution.
- 5. The Contractor shall secure and maintain insurance with the following minimum limits:

Extensive training and experience are required.*
